Dress Code

As an educational institution, a dress code has been outlined to avoid distractions in clothing and provide a certain level of uniformity. The dress code has been crafted to maintain a student body that looks respectable, is modest, and yet is comfortable. Students must be in dress code to attend school. If not in approved dress code, the student will be asked to wait in the office until a parent or guardian brings proper clothing.

Students are asked not to change out of school dress after school unless they are going directly to work from the school. While students are on school property, they are to abide by the school dress code.

WCA or Eagle logos are permitted and encouraged on school and athletic apparel. Please contact Vivian Lynn Embroidery (715-256-1212) to have your shirts embroidered. Brands should be limited to one side of the chest and not excessive in size.

LOWER SCHOOL GIRLS (K4-6TH)

Bottoms

- Polo Dress
 - Must touch the knee
 - Black, WCA purple, grey, white, navy blue, or light blue.
 - Leggings or tights may be worn underneath. Leggings or tights must be black, grey, white, or navy blue.
 - Must be from the school uniform section.
- Jumper
 - Khaki, Black
 - Must touch the knee
 - Must be accompanied with an approved color polo.
 - Leggings may be worn underneath. Leggings must be black, grey, white, or navy blue.
 - Must be from the school uniform section.
- Shorts
 - Khaki, Black
 - Must touch the knee
 - Must be from the school uniform section.
- Skorts
 - Khaki, Black
 - Must touch the knee
 - Must be from the school uniform section.

- Skirts
 - o Khaki, Black
 - o Must touch the knee
 - o Leggings may be worn underneath. Leggings must be black, grey, white, or navy blue.
 - o Must be from the school uniform section.
- Pants
 - o Khaki, Black
 - o Must be from the school uniform section.
 - o No leggings/jeggings
- Blue Jean pants (K4-4th only)
 - o No leggings/jeggings

LOWER SCHOOL BOYS (K4-6TH)

Bottoms

- Shorts
 - o Khaki, Black
 - o Must touch the knee
 - o Must be from the school uniform section.
- Pants
 - o Khaki, Black
 - o Must be from the school uniform section.
 - o No leggings/jeggings
- Blue Jean pants (K4-4th)
- A belt must be worn.

UPPER SCHOOL (7TH-12TH)

- Pants (girls, boys)
 - o Khaki, Black
 - o Must be from the school uniform section.
 - o No leggings/jeggings
 - o Boys must wear a belt.
- Skirt (girls)
 - o Khaki, Black
 - o Must be from the school uniform section.
 - o Must touch the knee
 - o Leggings may be worn underneath. Leggings must be black, grey, white, or navy blue.

TOPS (girls/boys K4-12th)

- Solid color Oxford or polo
 - o Black, WCA purple, grey, white, navy blue, or light blue.
 - o All but top button must be buttoned.

- Fleece jacket (if needed)
 - o Black, WCA purple, grey, white, navy blue, or light blue.
 - o Must not have a hood.
- Sweater (if needed)
 - o Black, WCA purple, grey, white, navy blue, or light blue.
 - o Must not have a hood.
- Boys' shirts must be tucked in.
- If worn, undershirts must be white and short sleeve.

SHOES (girls/boys K4-12th)

- Athletic shoes (tennis shoes)
- Boots
 - o No work boots.
 - o Must be removed prior to recess/gym time.
- Casual shoes (boat shoe, penny loafer)

HAIR (girls/boys K4-12th)

- Must be a natural cut and color.
- Boys must have a tapered haircut that is off their ears, eyes, and collar.
- Junior and senior boys may have facial hair with administrative approval.

EAGLE WEAR (Friday only)

- On Fridays, students may wear Eagle Wear to school.
- Blue jeans and a WCA Eagles shirt or sweatshirt may be worn.
- At athletic games, students must abide by Eagle Wear or dress code standards.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION

- All students in 3rd-12th grade PE are required to wear a PE uniform. The uniform will be used on each PE day. The PE uniform is available in the school office for \$15.

TRAVEL WEAR

- Student athletes in 7th-12th grade must wear travel wear to, from, and in between games (home and away).

***GENERAL NOTES ABOUT THE DRESS CODE:**

- Clothes should be clean and without rips or tears.
- Modesty should be practiced by each student (i.e., no excessive tightness).
- Socks and shoes should be worn daily.
- Fleece jackets must not have a hood.
